Prairie Avenue utility and street improvements continue

WAUKESHA — Planned utility and street improvement work along North and South Prairie Avenue between Philip and West St. Paul Avenue, along West Sunset Drive between Chapman Drive to Center Road and at the Fox River Parkway intersection is continuing this week.

The contractor is still working on two sections of the project: North and South Prairie Avenue, and West Sunset Drive.

Work planned for this week along Prairie Avenue includes pavement removal and excavation and grading for a new roadway, traffic signal pole base installations, concrete pavement pouring from the railroad tracks to West St. Paul Avenue, curb and gutter pouring and more.

Work along West Sunset Drive includes water main installation, traffic signal conduit installation and storm sewer installation. Work at the Fox River Parkway intersection and West Sunset Drive includes traffic signal pole base installation at West St. Paul Avenue and the North Prairie Avenue intersection.

North and South Prairie Avenue is closed to through traffic. The Prairie Avenue bridge over the Fox River is closed to all vehicular traffic.
